

SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMS AND COMMUNITY EVENT SPONSORSHIPS

SOLICITATION PROCESS

I. Background

On June 24, 2014, the Bernalillo County Commission adopted Administrative Resolution No. 2014-43 to establish internal procedures related to the funding of Social Services Programs and Community Event Sponsorships. The County provides limited funding for a broad range of Social Service Programs and Community Event Sponsorships needed to meet the needs of the community and to improve the quality of life for Bernalillo County residents.

II. Purpose

The Board of County Commissioners makes yearly appropriations for the purpose of funding Social Service Programs and Community Event Sponsorships to benefit County residents. The Office of Health and Social Services considers proposals from non-profit agencies duly registered and currently in good standing with the New Mexico Secretary of State's Office and have not-for-profit status under Section 501(c)3 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Service Code. Awards are made for Social Service Programs and Community Event Sponsorships that provide health and quality of life initiatives for Bernalillo County residents to improve economic well-being, education, health, and family and community development.

III. Solicitation and Award

Request for Proposals (RFP) for Social Services Programs are solicited based on community needs and availability of funds. The term of award may span multiple years.

Request for Proposals (RFP) for Community Event Sponsorships are solicited annually contingent on funding availability. Awarded events support activities that ensure access to cultural, health and quality of life initiatives.

The County awards proposals that are well planned, budgeted, have been deemed important to Bernalillo County. Awards are at the County's discretion. Submitting a proposal does not guarantee an award.
