

Fill Material Permit Application Attachment

Fill Material placed on a property shall meet all minimum listed setbacks below per Bernalillo County Code Sec. 30-83

| Distance | Item |
|---------------|---|
| 100 feet from | A liquid waste disposal system |
| 200 feet from | A private and/or public water supply |
| 100 feet from | An occupied dwelling or commercial building |
| 100 feet from | A watercourse* |

* Unless such fill material formation is controlled from motion by a concrete retaining wall, riprap, and/or other material acceptable to Bernalillo County.

Prohibited Fill Materials:

- (1) Organic materials including coal tar products, pesticides, wood of any kind and plastics
- (2) Hazardous waste
- (3) Any liquid, gaseous or solid waste which will pollute any waters within the county
- (4) Garbage
- (5) Rubbish
- (6) Commercial waste
- (7) Institutional waste
- (8) Industrial waste
- (9) Recreational waste
- (10) Yard waste

As-Filled Report:

An as-filled report shall be submitted to the authority by the person to whom a filled permit has been issued. The as-filled report shall either state that filling was done in substantial accordance with the permit, or described how actual filling differed from what had been proposed and permitted. The as-filled report shall be submitted to the authority within 30 days of completion of filling, but not later than 30 days after the time limit.

Final Cover Placement:

Any person receiving a permit to place fill material on private or public property shall be required to place the final cover material within a time period specified by the authority. In addition, the filled material will be sufficiently stabilized to prevent erosion and movement of fill material into arroyos, watercourses and/or adjacent land areas.
