RECRUITING HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS AND SENIORS  
TO SERVE ON ELECTION DAY

New Mexico State Law allows qualified high school juniors and seniors who are at least 16 years of age to serve as Student Election Clerks.

## Student Election Clerks needed for the Upcoming Election!

### WHO CAN APPLY?

- Students must be a U.S. Citizen at least 16 years old
- Must have written permission from parent(s) or legal guardian, unless emancipated.
- Students cannot be related to any candidate currently on the ballot.



### PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Gain real-life work experience, which may apply for a special project in government or a civics class, or on college admission applications.
- Fulfill an important civic duty.
- Meet and work with interesting people in your community.
- Break out of the classroom routine, and
- Earn a little extra cash! Student Election Clerks are paid \$150 for working Election Day.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with the opening and closing of the polling place
- Check in voters
- Help ensure a fair and accurate election

### TRAINING

Student Clerks are required to attend a four-hour training session prior to the election and are paid \$35 after the election. Students will learn about the election process, the importance of maintaining the integrity of the election, and their roles on Election Day.
