




# Carlito Springs Ribbon-cutting

Carlito Springs, located on the southeast face of the Sandia Mountains, encompasses 179 acres and ranges in elevation from 6,300 feet to 7,000 feet. On August 16, Bernalillo



County is celebrating the first ever opening of Carlito Springs. This event will introduce visitors to the newly established trailhead and trail that traverses this majestic property and leads to historic cabins, a travertine house, springs and ponds. A guest speaker with the East Mountain Historical Society will then present on Carl Magee, one of the founding and renowned owners.
