Portraits and landscape photographs by Native American photographer Lee Marmon from Laguna Pueblo were recently purchased for the 1% for the Art Collection. Marmon is globally recognized for his portraits of tribal elders and who were the last generation to live by their traditional ways and values. Marmon's work has appeared in the *The New York Times*, *The Saturday Evening Post* and *Time*. In 2006, he received the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Santa Fe-based Southwestern Association for Indian Arts for the "legacy of integrity" his works have inspired during the 59 years that Marmon has been practicing craft.

Reg Loving has shown extensively in Santa Fe and is well known for his abstractions and landscape paintings. His paintings, using acrylic and marble dust, have a sensuous texture and depth. He recently exhibited in an invitational shown at the Museum of New Mexico in Albuquerque.
