8 3. Shall Bernalillo County, New Mexico, be authorized to issue its general
 9 obligation bonds, in one series or more, in an aggregate principal amount
 10 not exceeding \$6,460,000 for the purpose of acquiring property,
 11 constructing, and equipping recreational facilities, including compliance
 12 with the Americans With Disabilities Act, within the County, said bonds
 13 to be payable from general (ad valorem) taxes and to be issued and sold at
 14 such time or times, upon such terms and conditions as the Board of
 15 County Commissioners may determine and as permitted by law?


17 4. Shall Bernalillo County, New Mexico, be authorized to issue its general
 18 obligation bonds, in one series or more, in an aggregate principal amount
 19 not exceeding \$9,070,000 for the purpose of securing funds for the
 20 acquisition of property, design, construction and repair of roads and
 21 related non-motor vehicle pathways within Bernalillo County, New
 22 Mexico, said bonds to be payable from general (ad valorem) taxes and to
 23 be issued and sold at such time or times, upon such terms and conditions
 24 as the Board of County Commissioners may determine and as permitted
 25 by law?

27 5. Shall the County of Bernalillo, New Mexico, be authorized to issue its
 28 general obligation bonds, in one series or more, in an aggregate principal
 29 amount not exceeding \$4,500,000 for the purpose securing funds for the
 30 acquisition of property, design, construction and repair of storm sewer,
 31 wastewater, water, and fiber optic systems within Bernalillo County, New
 32 Mexico, said bonds to be payable from general (ad valorem) taxes and to
 33 be issued and sold at such time or times, upon such terms and conditions
 34 as the Board of County Commissioners may determine and as permitted
 35 by law?


37 **SECTION 2.** The date and details of such election shall be provided by separate




